

LOCATION



Surrey History Centre is located at 130 Goldsworth Road in Woking. It is approximately 2/3 of a mile from the Train and Bus Stations via the pedestrian route. Exit the train Station on the northern or town side i.e. from Platform 1.

PARKING

Parking is available free of charge at the Surrey History Centre. Access to the car park is from Kingsway at the rear of the building.

LUNCH

You are welcome to bring a packed lunch, tea and coffee will be available. The Surrey History Centre is about 15 minutes walk from Woking Town centre with its coffee shops, cafes and bakeries. Morrison's Supermarket, which is about 5 minutes walk away, has a café and also sells sandwiches and salads etc.
