Dr. Jonathan Foyle, formerly Curator of Historic Buildings at Historic Royal Palaces, is currently Chief Executive of World Monuments Fund Britain. His thesis on Cardinal Wolsey's Hampton Court led to a British Academy award to research continental influences on early 16th century Britain.

He has lectured widely in the UK, Europe and the US and his television career has included BBC1's The One Show, History Channel's 'Lost Worlds' series, and in 2009 he presented a documentary on Henry VIII: Patron and Plunderer which explored the king's use of the arts.
