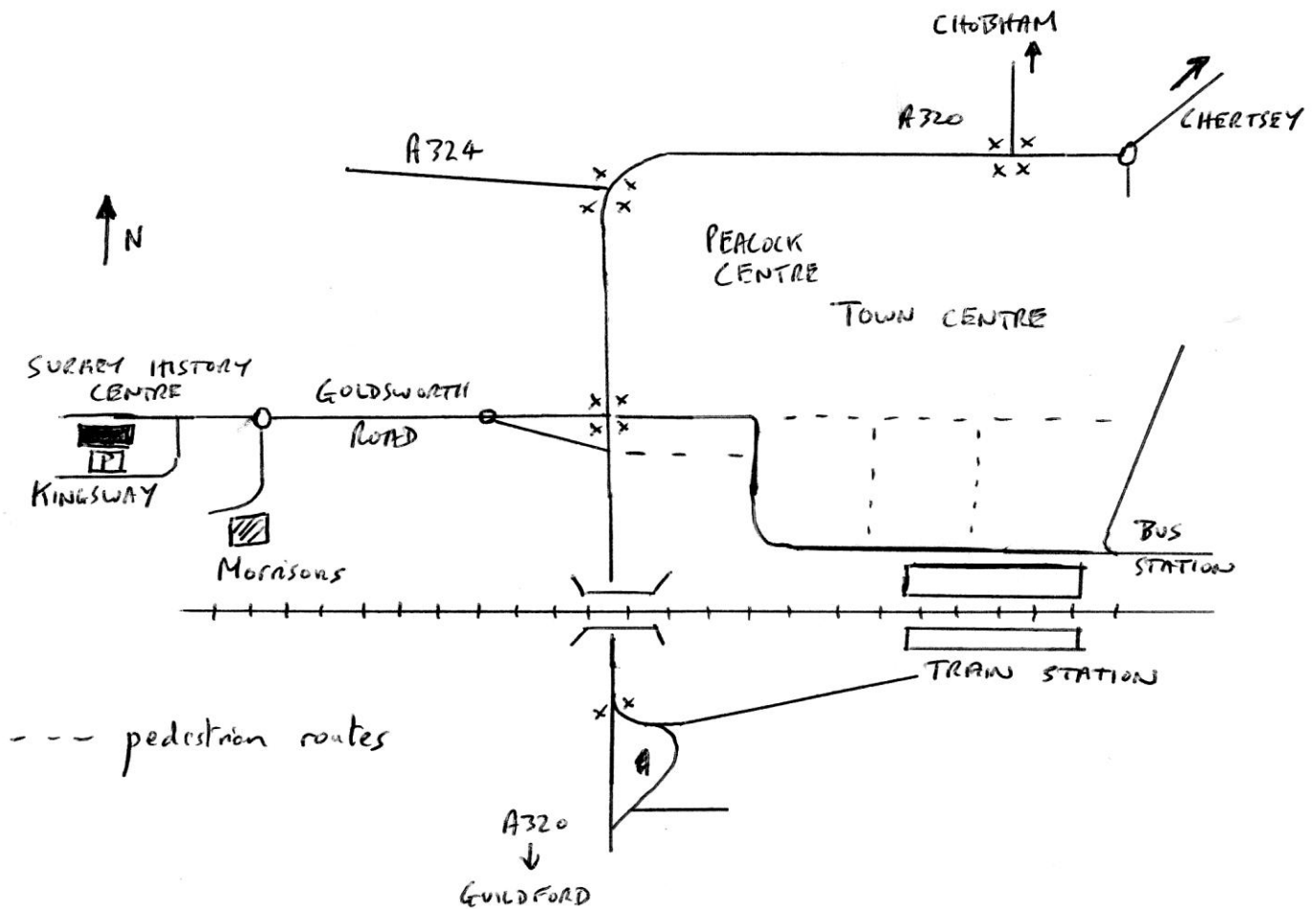

## Location of Surrey History Centre



Surrey History Centre is located at 130 Goldsworth Road in Woking. It is approximately 2/3 of a mile from the Train and Bus Stations via the pedestrian route. Exit the train Station on the northern or town side i.e. from Platform 1.

### PARKING

Parking is available free of charge at the Surrey History Centre. Access to the car park is from Kingsway at the rear of the building.

### LUNCH

You are welcome to bring a packed lunch, tea and coffee will be available. The Surrey History Centre is about a 15 minute walk from Woking Town centre with its coffee shops, cafes and bakeries.
